What You Can Do As Parents



- Take an active and regular interest in your child's schooling.
- Support and encourage learning by involving in formal or informal learning yourself.
- Remember that your school experience is very different from theirs.

What You Can Do As Parents



- Set aside a family “Quiet Time” so that every family member can engage in learning.
- Set up a conducive study area. Function is more important than style.
- Make sure your child goes to school each day well-fed, well-rested, and with a positive outlook of school.

What You Can Do As Parents



- Allow your child to study in the way they learn best. But hold them accountable to progress.
- NO TV! What about Handphones? Music?
- Work with teachers periodically and remember we, being partners, both want the same thing for the child.

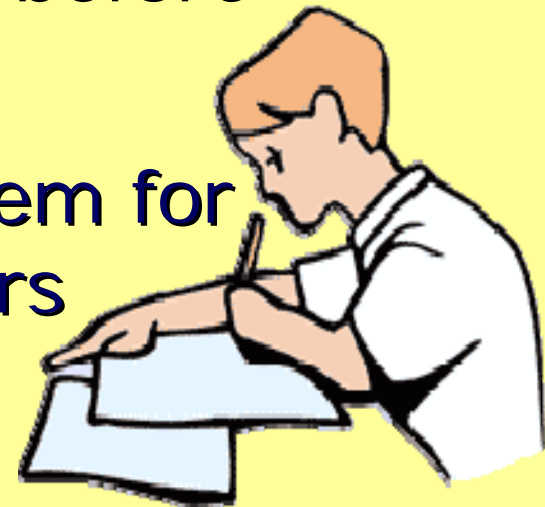
What You Can Advise Your Child

- Try not to do too much studying at one time.
- Plan specific time for studying.
- Try to study at the same time of the day at each day.
- Set specific goals for each study time.



What You Can Advise Your Child

- Start studying when planned.
- Work on exercises or topics found most difficult first.
- Review notes / textbook before doing the exercises.
- Tell friends not to call them for non-study-related matters during study time.




What You Can Advise Your Child

- Call friends when help is needed with study-related matters.
- Find some time to review school work over the weekend.
